## Lion Brand Baby's First Sea Blue Baby Afghan

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 28 x 30 in. (71 x 76 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 925-146 [Lion Brand Baby's First Yarn: Sea Sprite](#)  
5 Balls
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

### GAUGE:

4 V-sts + 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**V-st** (Dc, ch 1, dc) all in the same st.

### AFGHAN

**Ch 85.**  
**Row 1:** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in 5th ch from hook (V-st made), \*sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from \* across to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch - 27 V-sts at end of this row.

**Rows 3-40:** Ch 3, turn, V-st in each ch-1 sp across, dc in turning ch.  
Do not fasten off.

### Border

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, turn, work sc evenly spaced around all edges of Afghan, working 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 2 (picot edging):** \*Ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook (picot made), sk next sc, sl st in next 2 sc; rep from \* around. **Note:** At each corner, sl st in more or fewer sts to ensure that a picot is centered on the corner.  
Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
