The Tasmanian Screech Owl is an exercise in minimalism. Each stitch in this design has a purpose. It is dark and sketchy to give a fleeting look at the nocturnal creature. In the wild it can be heard soon after nightfall, its blood-curdling screech letting you know it is about. It is worked with one strand of 6-stranded cotton on a stretched organza base. The colors are muted and earthy, mimicking its habitat.

Gary was born and lives in Tasmania, Australia. He has written six books on embroidery as well as taught and lectured on embroidery in England, New Zealand, Canada, United States, and throughout Australia.
