


PSR MEMBERS...YOU ARE INVITED TO AN ORANGE COUNTY WORKSHOP



At the fall PSR Region Meeting Orange County Chapter promised a workshop for “Caterina Rose” which will start in June, 2021. This gives PSR members a chance to think about it, decide and then notify me. The project will be open to all PSR members without having to join the Orange County Chapter.

Caterina de Medici is very similar to blackwork but worked on a large count – 16 to 19 thread count – linen and stitched with a heavy cotton yarn. The project was designed by Linda Leone and will be taught by Linda. The cost will include the chart and instructions, imported buratto linen and cotton yarn to stitch the project. The instructions were tested by Claudia Kilmit and you know what a great teacher she is. There should be no problems with those instructions. Linda designed the project in 2015 after seeing the buratto linen at the 2014 National Seminar and fell in love with it. It is easy to work with and the linen seems to soften and feel silken as it is stitched. By the time you have finished the project you will have executed the stitches multiple times.

The workshop comes at an opportune time since the “Inspirations” Magazine issue no. 107 showcases the technique. For those who want to delve into Caterina de Medici further there may be a few copies of “Inspirations” available on the internet.

This is an ideal time to experience Caterina de Medici without having to go through the process of ordering imported linen and cotton from Italy. The work has been done for you. The workshop will be taught via Zoom in several sessions. The cost of \$25.00... includes the linen, yarn, instructions and mailing. All other supplies are something you will have in your needle supplies.
