WISCONSIN STATE DAY 2021

The Madison Area Chapter of the Embroiderers' Guild of America invites you to attend the Great Lakes Region, Wisconsin State Day in Madison, Wisconsin on June 18-19, 2021. Our State Day will focus on crewel embroidery with national teacher, Canby Robertson.

Canby is a Life member of the Embroiderers' Guild of America. She has an EGA Master Craftsman's Certificate in crewel embroidery and is a Gold Thread Award winner from the Mid Atlantic Region. Canby will teach a 2-day workshop featuring traditional English crewel embroidery. The workshop project is Bess's Bed Hangings.

Canby will educate workshop participants on the use of crewel in 18th Century England, as well as instruct us on the related history of English wool and dyes used during this time period. Workshop members will specifically learn how to create period stitches to execute our project.

Day one will focus on preparing the project. Good technique, care of the linen, the properties of wool fibers and how to choose the correct needle size will all be addressed.

Day two will be spent working on the project. Canby will continue to discuss good techniques and how to properly block to finish the project.

The class fee will be \$110. The kit fee is an additional \$95. The kit will include an instruction booklet, linen twill with a design transfer and 8 values of Appletons Crewel wool, a pencil, a photo representation and crewel needles. A registration fee of \$20 is due by 3/30/2021. A registration form can be found at: [Madison Area EGA Chapter - Home](#) under the administration link. The class location will be at Bethany United Methodist Church, 3910 Mineral Point Road, Madison WI.
